

# DRINKING WATER WARNING RESOLVED

Manti City

## BOIL ADVISORY LIFTED

Due to a significant rain event on July 1<sup>st</sup>, Manti City issued a precautionary boil advisory, as cloudy water from two of our spring collection areas made it into our culinary distribution system. The springs that caused the issue were immediately turned out of service and samples were taken regularly over the next two days and submitted to the Central Utah Health Dept for safety testing. We worked closely with professionals at the Central Utah Health Department and the Utah State Division of Drinking Water to determine that our culinary water is safe for drinking. Since some water made it into the distribution system a boil advisory was put into place until the results of all required samples were analyzed. On July 1<sup>st</sup> two samples were delivered to Central Utah Health Department, on July 2<sup>nd</sup> 4 more samples were delivered in the morning and 5 more samples in the evening. The results of the samples were negative for E coli. As a result, we are able to lift the precautionary boil advisory.
